

**MINUTES OF A WORK SESSION OF HISTORIC PRESERVATION
COMMISSION HELD FEBRUARY 10, 2009**

The Historic Preservation Commission of the City of Eufaula met in work session Tuesday, February 10, 2009, at 3:30 p.m. in the Municipal Courtroom at the Eufaula Police Department Complex, 545 East Barbour Street. Upon call of the roll the following members were present: Chairman David Ongemach, Vice Chairman Curtis Williams, Joel Smith, Sr., Judi Mathisen and Bruce Turner. Absent: Terry Honan and Doug Purcell.

Also present: Tiffany Woo and Jim Mathisen.

It was noted Tim Milner had e-mailed Commission members notification of an approved work review for repair of the awning and rotted window framing at the Calton building.

The Commission discussed a list of open items that were forwarded to Chairman Ongemach by the previous chairman:

- The balustrade on the Bennett home has not been replaced and needs a certificate of appropriateness
- Chris Sellers was to return in December with information concerning his renovation plan
- Chimneys were removed at the Simms house
- Martin Theatre – chimneys, front wall and façade
- Los Portales Mexican Restaurant signage
- Yamandu Acosta's access ramp; it was agreed he would remove it if it was no longer needed
- No reply from Mr. Hitson re: Bluff City Inn
- Year-end report to Alabama Historic Commission
- Postcard mailing to property owners in the district
- Commission members' continuing education

There being no further business to come before the Commission, motion was duly made and seconded to adjourn.
