

MINUTES OF A WORK SESSION OF HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION HELD MARCH 10, 2009

The Historic Preservation Commission of the City of Eufaula met in work session Tuesday, March 10, 2009, at 3:30 p.m. in the Municipal Courtroom at the Eufaula Police Department Complex, 545 East Barbour Street. Upon call of the roll the following members were present: Vice Chairman Curtis Williams, Terry Honan, Bruce Turner, Judi Mathisen. Joel Smith, Sr., entered the meeting at 3:45 p.m. Absent: Chairman David Ongemach, Doug Purcell.

Also present: Paul and Stella Matherne.

Vice Chairman Williams called the meeting to order and noted the following work reviewed have been approved by the building department and no action is needed by the Commission:

- Eric and Donna Fiel – 422 N. Randolph Avenue – Repair front porch columns, bases; replace floorboards and joists as needed; no material change
- James and Sandra Gulledge – 312 N. Randolph Avenue – Reroof; no material change with exception color of new roof to appear darker due to faded color of existing roofing material
- Sonny Harrison – 104 East Broad Street – Recoating existing roof; no material change

Discussion was held regarding removal of the chimneys from the Thornton-Rudderman home and the Simms-Fiel home while they were being re-roofed. It was the consensus of the Commission members present that the Chairman be asked to write a letter to the homeowners and ask that the chimneys be rebuilt.

Mr. Honan also requested the Chairman be asked to write Chris Sellers to attend the April meeting.

Mr. Honan pointed out Steve Rogers, owner of Shady Oaks Thrift Store, has done a nice job of painting the exterior of the building, and he would like the Chairman to write a letter thanking him for his efforts.

Discussion was held regarding continuing education opportunities for Commission members. Vice Chairman Williams stated he will call Mary Shell at the Alabama Historic Commission and see what opportunities are available or if someone from the AHC would be available to come to Eufaula to speak to the Commission.

There being no further business to come before the Commission, motion was duly made and seconded to adjourn.
