

**MINUTES OF A WORK SESSION OF THE HISTORIC PRESERVATION
COMMISSION HELD MARCH 11, 2008**

The Historic Preservation Commission of the City of Eufaula met in work session on Tuesday, March 11, 2008, at 3:30 p.m. in the Municipal Courtroom at the Eufaula Police Department Complex. Upon call of the roll the following members were present: Chairman Terry Honan, Joel Smith, Sr., David Ongemach, Bruce Turner. Doug Purcell entered the meeting at 3:52 p.m. Absent: Vice Chairman Curtis Williams, Mary Winkleblack.

Chairman Terry Honan presided over the work session.

Chairman Honan stated he has met with the new owners of the Russell-Jarrett home and they will be doing repair to the property that will require coming before the Commission for approval.

Discussion was held regarding whose responsibility it is to inform new property owners of the Commission's Design Guidelines and that their property is located within the Locally Designated Historic District.

Discussion was held regarding the re-installation of the Fairview Cemetery fence on North Randolph Avenue. Chairman Honan stated he spoke with Mayor Jaxon and he will be submitting a letter to the Commission stating that funding was not available to complete the project as originally planned with brickwork, therefore the fence was installed based upon the Commission's original recommendation.

Chairman Honan stated he will be following up with Judy and David Ray regarding their storage building.

Chairman Honan stated he will also follow up with Robert Bennett regarding replacement of the balustrade.

There being no further business to come before the Commission, motion was duly made and seconded to adjourn.
