

**MINUTES OF A WORK SESSION OF HISTORIC PRESERVATION
COMMISSION HELD JUNE 10, 2008**

The Historic Preservation Commission of the City of Eufaula met in work session on Tuesday, June 10, 2008, at 3:30 p.m. in the Municipal Courtroom at the Eufaula Police Department Complex. Upon call of the roll the following members were present: Chairman Terry Honan, Doug Purcell, Joel Smith, Sr., David Ongemach. Absent: Vice Chairman Curtis Williams, Bruce Turner.

Chairman Honan welcomed visitors to the meeting: Yamandu Acosta and Tiffany Woo.

Chairman Honan called upon Mr. Acosta to address the Commission. Mr. Acosta requested the Commission hold a special session to hear an application for certificate of appropriateness to build a handicapped access ramp at the south side entrance of 403 North Randolph Avenue. Mr. Acosta stated the ramp will be a temporary structure, built in sections, and will be 38 feet in length with a cement walkway to the sidewalk. Chairman Honan suggested Mr. Acosta speak with the city building inspector prior to developing his plans, and cautioned him not to begin work on the structure until the Commission could act on an official certificate of appropriateness application. After discussion, it was determined a special meeting of the Commission would be held Wednesday, June 18, at 3:00 p.m. at the Chamber of Commerce building immediately following a work session on façade easements.

Discussion was held concerning the June 18th work session on façade easements.

There being no further business to come before the work session, motion was duly made and seconded to adjourn.
