

**MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION
HELD JUNE 18, 2008**

The Historic Preservation Commission of the City of Eufaula met in special session Wednesday, June 18, 2008, at 3:00 p.m. at the James S. Clark Center. Upon call of the roll the following members were present: Chairman Terry Honan, Vice Chairman Curtis Williams, Joel Smith, Sr., Doug Purcell, David Ongemach, Bruce Turner. Absent: None.

Chairman Honan stated the first item of business was a request for Certificate of Appropriateness by Yamandu Acosta, 403 North Randolph Avenue, for permission to build a handicapped access ramp at the south side entrance of the property. Chairman Honan noted there was no one present to represent the application. The Commission secretary telephoned the City's police department complex (where meetings are usually held) to make sure the applicant had not mistakenly gone to the wrong place. He was not there. She then telephoned his home and was told he was not there, but they would attempt to locate him and have him come to the meeting as soon as possible.

Chairman Honan moved on to other business.

Discussion was held concerning a sign that has been placed at a new Mexican restaurant in the Bluff City Inn building. No certificate of appropriateness has been issued for the sign. Chairman Honan asked the secretary to have the building inspector check the status of the sign and report back to the Commission.

Chairman Honan again noted there was no one present to address the Commission on behalf of the Acosta application and asked the wishes of the Commission. After discussion, motion by Mr. Ongemach to deny the application because of lack of representation by the applicant. Mr. Williams seconded the motion. Roll call vote was recorded as follows: Yeas: Chairman Honan, Vice Chairman Williams, Mr. Smith, Mr. Purcell, Mr. Ongemach, Mr. Turner. Nays: None. Motion carried.

There being no further business to come before the Commission, motion was duly made and seconded to adjourn at 3:14 p.m.
