

**MINUTES OF A MEETING OF A WORK SESSION OF HISTORIC
PRESERVATION COMMISSION HELD SEPTEMBER 9, 2008**

The Historic Preservation Commission of the City of Eufaula met in work session September 9, 2008 at 3:30 p.m. in the Municipal Courtroom at the Eufaula Police Department. Upon call of the roll the following members were present: Chairman Terry Honan, Joel Smith, Sr., Doug Purcell, David Ongemach, Bruce Turner. Absent: Vice Chairman Curtis Williams. Also present: Tiffany Woo, The Eufaula Tribune.

Chairman Honan called the meeting to order.

Chairman Honan presented several receipts and requested they be forwarded through the proper channels for reimbursement through the state grant proceeds. He discussed several items he has recently purchased for the Commission's book and periodical collection.

Discussion was held regarding the Martin-Bullock-Ballowe-Sellers project. Chairman Honan stated a letter was sent by certified mail asking Mr. Sellers to attend today's meeting to address several concerns of the Commission. Chairman Honan stated if Mr. Sellers does not show at today's meeting, he will send another letter advising it is the intent of the Commission to take him to court.

In other business, Mr. Purcell pointed out it has been 18 months since the Bluff City Inn's certificate of appropriateness was approved. He asked the chairman to write a letter to Mr. Hitson inquiring of his plans for the property. Mr. Purcell further stated he has met with an individual who believes the building is salvageable and doesn't need to be torn down. The individual is interested in funding an independent feasibility study.

There being no further business to come before the Commission, motion was duly made and seconded to adjourn.
