

**MINUTES OF A SPECIAL CALLED MEETING OF THE EUFAULA CITY COUNCIL
HELD ON MONDAY, OCTOBER 12, 2020 AT 5:15 P.M.**

The Eufaula City Council met in special called session October 12, 2020 at 5:15 p.m. at the Police Department court room at 545 East Barbour Street. Council President Knight called the meeting to order. Upon call of the roll the following members were present: President Johnny A. Knight, President Pro Tem Barbara C. Flurry, Lucious Cobbs, Linda S. Grice, and Tony L. Robertson.

Also present: City Clerk Joy White, City Attorney Joel Smith, Councilmember-elect John Wayne Robinson of District IV, Councilmember-elect Wes Register of District V, and Ms. Julie Hill, Barbour County Board of Registrars.

Council President Knight stated that the purpose of the meeting was to address Resolution 102-2020 (Canvass Votes Municipal Run-off Election 10 06 2020).

Ms. Julie Hill announced that there were two provisional ballots that were rejected, and explained that a rejected ballot is often the result of a voter attempting to vote in a different district other than the district where they currently reside, or they have not provided valid identification. Ms. Hill continued that there is a new law that applies to municipalities that if a resident should move to another district, they must adhere to the 14-day deadline to register to vote in their new district where they have moved and intend to reside.

Mrs. Grice offered a motion to adopt Resolution 102-2020 (Canvass Votes Municipal Run-off Election 10 06 2020) for the run-off election held on October 6, 2020, and that the votes be accepted as counted, verified, and recorded. Mrs. Flurry seconded the motion. After a voice vote, Council President Knight announced that the motion had carried.

WHEREAS, the municipal run-off election for District 4 for the City of Eufaula, Alabama, was duly and legally held on October 6, 2020, as provided by law; and

WHEREAS, the municipal governing body of the City of Eufaula, Alabama, met on this 12th day of October, 2020, a quorum thereof being present, at 5:15 p.m. and has canvassed the returns, and has ascertained and determined the number of votes received by each candidate; and

WHEREAS, the said municipal governing body has ascertained and determined the result of said election as follows:
